Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Volunteers Players	Consent	Parents of all players have signed a consent form highlighting the risks of transmitting COVID-19 by returning to training and consenting to their voluntary return. They will sign to say they have had no symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days and must not attend training if they develop any symptoms or fit into the self-isolating categories.	All

Misunderstanding of responsibility for a COVID 19 secure environment	Volunteers Players Parents	Communication	Through the clubs' communication processes (e.g. age group managers, KDR JFC committee, KDRJFC website) parents and volunteers are made aware it is Kirk Deighton Rangers JFC who are responsible, as the hiring party, for ensuring a COVID 19 safe environment on the WHS pitch during the time period of the club hire (notwithstanding WHS general Health and Safety responsibilities as the facility provider)	KDR JFC
Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Volunteers Players	Self-Screening	<p>Each participant must undertake the FA's COVID 19 self-screen check list before travelling to a training session or other football activity. If they answer 'yes' to any one of them they should not travel to the training session and follow all applicable Government</p> <p>Coaches at the club should check that each participant completed the self-screen check list before attending and if so, if the self-screen checks were negative for all participants.</p> <p>If a participant says they forgot to self-check before their arrival, then the coach should ask them the health check questions before they join any group at the facility. If they answer 'yes' to one or more of the questions, participants must not take part in the activity and should be told to safely return home. This should be for their personal use only and should be clearly marked with their name</p> <p>Between each drill coaches will encourage players to use their hand sanitiser.</p>	All

Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Volunteers Players Spectators	Social distancing	<p>A 'keep left' system will operate for entry and exit to the WHS facility</p> <p>Cones (appropriately spaced out) will be already in place at the session. Each player will place their belongings on the cone and remain there until the session begins.</p> <p>Parents and players will be advised to socially distance walking from/to WHS car park to the pitch and to maintain social distancing while spectating</p>	All
Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Volunteers Players	PPE	<p>PPE will be worn by coaches when dealing with a first aid situation (gloves, apron and face mask) therefore these will be available in the first aid bags.</p> <p>Appropriate disposal of PPE will be adhered to</p>	First aiders/ coaches
Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Volunteers Players Spectators	Environment measures	<p>There will be no changing room access</p> <p>There will be no toilet facilities available</p> <p>Entry/exit to the WHS facility will be through open gateways so users will not need to touch gates.</p>	All
Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Volunteers Players	Facility and equipment cleaning	<p>Balls, cones and any football equipment will be disinfected after every use</p> <p>Use of bibs will be minimised. No sharing of bibs will take place. Bibs will be washed between every session. Only the coach with responsibility for washing the bibs will collect them.</p>	Coaches

Non-adherence to supporting NHS Track and Trace	Community	Contact details	<p>Only players and their parent/carer will be allowed to access the WHS facility during Kirk Deighton Rangers hiring time. KDR JFC updated our Data Privacy Policy/ Notices to cover data handling of attendees to aid NHS Test and Trace. The club retains the contact details of all parents/carers of the children at the club.</p> <p>Coaches will keep a record of players attending the WHS facility</p> <p>KDR JFC will encourage the use of the NHS COVID App at the WHS facility pointing out the QR codes WHS has put in place at the facility</p>	KDR JFC
Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Volunteers Players	Isolating	<p>If a suspected case occurs at training that person will be sent straight home to self isolate.</p> <p>Coaches have a list of parental contact numbers. A coach will put on their PPE and wait with the suspected case (appropriately socially distanced) until they are collected by someone in their support bubble.</p>	Coaches
Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Players	Player considerations	<p>Players will travel to training/matches only with people from their household or within their support bubble</p> <p>Players will arrive in kit and will have no access to the changing room/ shower facilities</p> <p>Player will bring their own water bottle / inhalers / hand sanitisers which will be clearly marked with their name.</p>	All
Health and safety risks	Players Volunteers	Health and safety considerations	<p>All non COVID-19 health and safety and fire policies will be adhered to</p> <p>Any changes to requirements will be communicated swiftly and effectively</p>	All

Spread of COVID-19 Coronavirus	Players	Player behaviour	<p>Players will follow the COVID 19 code of behaviour</p> <p>Players will be told not to spit</p> <p>Players will be told not to use chewing gum</p> <p>Players will be told not to shout while facing another person at close distance</p> <p>When coughing/ sneezing players will be advised to cover their mouth with a tissue/ sleeve/ elbow area and not use their hands. They will use hand sanitiser directly afterwards and tissues will be correctly disposed of.</p> <p>At training players will be told not to touch the ball with their hands (except GK wearing gloves)</p>	Players Coaches
