



Grange Park - Car Parking Guidelines

Turn up between 9 - 9.15 OR at least 45 minutes before kick-off

Need 6 people ideally from all member Clubs (4 minimum)

- 2 manage main car park, 1 to support (then move to overflow/grass bank)
- 1 on driveway in to direct into grass bank (if being used) & parking on either side of the driveway/entrance road
 - **NOT** the road to the club with the river on your left. No parking allowed here.
- 1 at driveway turning circle/entrance
- 1 on either
 - Turn into Grange Park to manage drop off when using overflow
 - On grass bank to ensure correct parking and manage parking on grass
 - Area by the side of the Rugby 2nd XV pitch (if used)
- **High Vis jackets are in the large green football container in a bag just by the entrance door - or from behind the bar.**
- **The overflow car park by the main roundabout will be open if required.**

If using overflow

- Overflow car park needs to be requested to be open prior to Sunday (done by Rugby Fixtures Sec, Kris). This will already be done for you
- Take cone down to main entrance to use as a roundabout for drop offs
- Club officials will lock up when they leave

Parking

- **Park everyone in main car park first.**
 - From left as you drive in. 1 row next to bowling club, 2 rows down centre, 1 row next to playground/container.
 - Rest of the spaces are marked on the tarmac
 - Priority, where possible, given to Coaches & Referees
 - 4x4's to park on grass either side of driveway, grass bank & side of Rugby 2nd XV pitch

Grass Bank Parking

- One row against the fence, gap, then 2 rows of cars, gap and repeat

Extra parking (side of Rugby 2nd XV pitch)

- Park against the fence on left, leave gap, one further column of cars but keep a reasonable distance from pitch

Overflow

- One parking attendant to man the entrance from the main road sending people directly into the main car park. Self explanatory for parking, no need to supervise.

Any issues, feedback on notes or abuse, report directly to the Junior Club officials.

- We will not tolerate any abuse of volunteers. All clubs are pre-warned of the use of the overflow and if they haven't told their parents that is an issue for their club.
- All clubs have a car parking challenge, and our system is one of the better ones
